### What you should know

- **Primary Care Physician (PCP):** A PCP is important for helping to coordinate care and this plan requires you to select a PCP. When you enroll, we'll ask who your PCP is. If you don't tell us, we'll assign one to you. You can always change the PCP by calling us.
- **Referrals:** In most cases, your PCP must give you approval before you can use other providers in the network. You don't need a referral for emergency or urgently needed care.
- **Network:** Our plan has a network of select providers to provide you with patient centric care, coordinated services and enhanced provider communication. To locate a network provider you may contact Member Services or search the online provider directory.
- **Prior authorizations:** Your provider will work with us to get approval before you receive certain services or drugs. Benefits that may require a prior authorization are listed with an asterisk (\*) in the benefits grid.

Before making an enrollment decision, it is important that you fully understand our benefits and rules. From October 1 to March 31, you can call us 7 days a week from 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. local time. From April 1 to September 30, we're here Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. local time.

## Understanding the benefits

- Review the full list of benefits found in the Evidence of Coverage (EOC), especially those services for which you routinely see a doctor. Visit **AetnaMedicare.com** or call **1-833-859-6031 (TTY: 711)** to view a copy of the EOC.
- Review the provider directory (or ask your doctor) to make sure the doctors you see now are in the network. If they are not listed, it means you will likely have to select a new doctor.
- Review the pharmacy directory to make sure the pharmacy you use for any prescription medicine is in the network. If the pharmacy is not listed, you will likely have to select a new pharmacy for your prescriptions.

## Understanding important rules

- You must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.
- Benefits, premiums and/or copayments/co-insurance may change on January 1, 2023.
- Except in emergency or urgent situations, we do not cover services by out-of-network providers (doctors who are not listed in the provider directory).

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Aetna Medicare is a HMO, PPO plan with a Medicare contract. Our SNPs also have contracts with State Medicaid programs. Enrollment in our plans depends on contract renewal.

Out-of-network/non-contracted providers are under no obligation to treat Aetna members, except in emergency situations. The formulary, provider and/or pharmacy network may change at any time. You will receive notice when necessary. Aetna Medicare's pharmacy network includes limited lower cost, preferred pharmacies in: Suburban Arizona, Suburban Illinois, Urban Kansas, Rural Michigan, Urban Michigan, Urban Missouri and Suburban West Virginia. The lower costs advertised in our plan materials for these pharmacies may not be available at the pharmacy you use. For up-to-date information about our network pharmacies, including whether there are any lower-cost preferred pharmacies in your area, members please call the number on your ID card, non-members please call 1-833-859-6031 (TTY: 711) or consult the online pharmacy directory at [AetnaMedicare.com/findpharmacy](https://www.aetna.com/medicare/findpharmacy). For mail-order, you can get prescription drugs shipped to your home through the network mail-order delivery program. Typically, mail-order drugs arrive within 10 days. You can call the number on your ID card if you do not receive your mail-order drugs within this timeframe. Members may have the option to sign-up for automated mail-order delivery. Members who get “Extra Help” are not required to fill prescriptions at preferred network pharmacies in order to get Low Income Subsidy (LIS) copays.
